DOG BINS: Please note that The Dogs (Fouling of Land) Act 1996 applies. Beaches are amongst the most common areas patrolled by officers enforcing the above Act and fixed penalty notices are issued on a regular basis. Please 'pick up' after your dog and where available use the dog waste bins provided.

DOG WELFARE: please remember that in hot weather beaches may not be the ideal place to take your dog. Due to the lack of shade or inadequate fresh water, your dog may suffer from heat related problems.

If you are concerned about any dog welfare issue, such as a dog left in a car during hot weather, please contact the **RSPCA on 08705 555999**
 24 hr service (calls at BT national rates).

LOST DOGS: If you have lost your dog, please contact the appropriate local council as soon as possible to ensure you are not put to unnecessary expense for kennelling etc. All dogs are required by law to wear a collar and tag bearing the name and address of the owners. If you are on holiday it is a good idea to have a temporary tag with your holiday address on it.

Please note that some beaches are unsafe for swimming. At all other beaches we ask that you swim with care and follow the advice given by lifeguards.

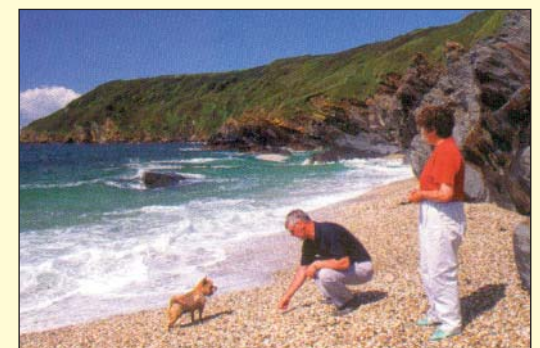
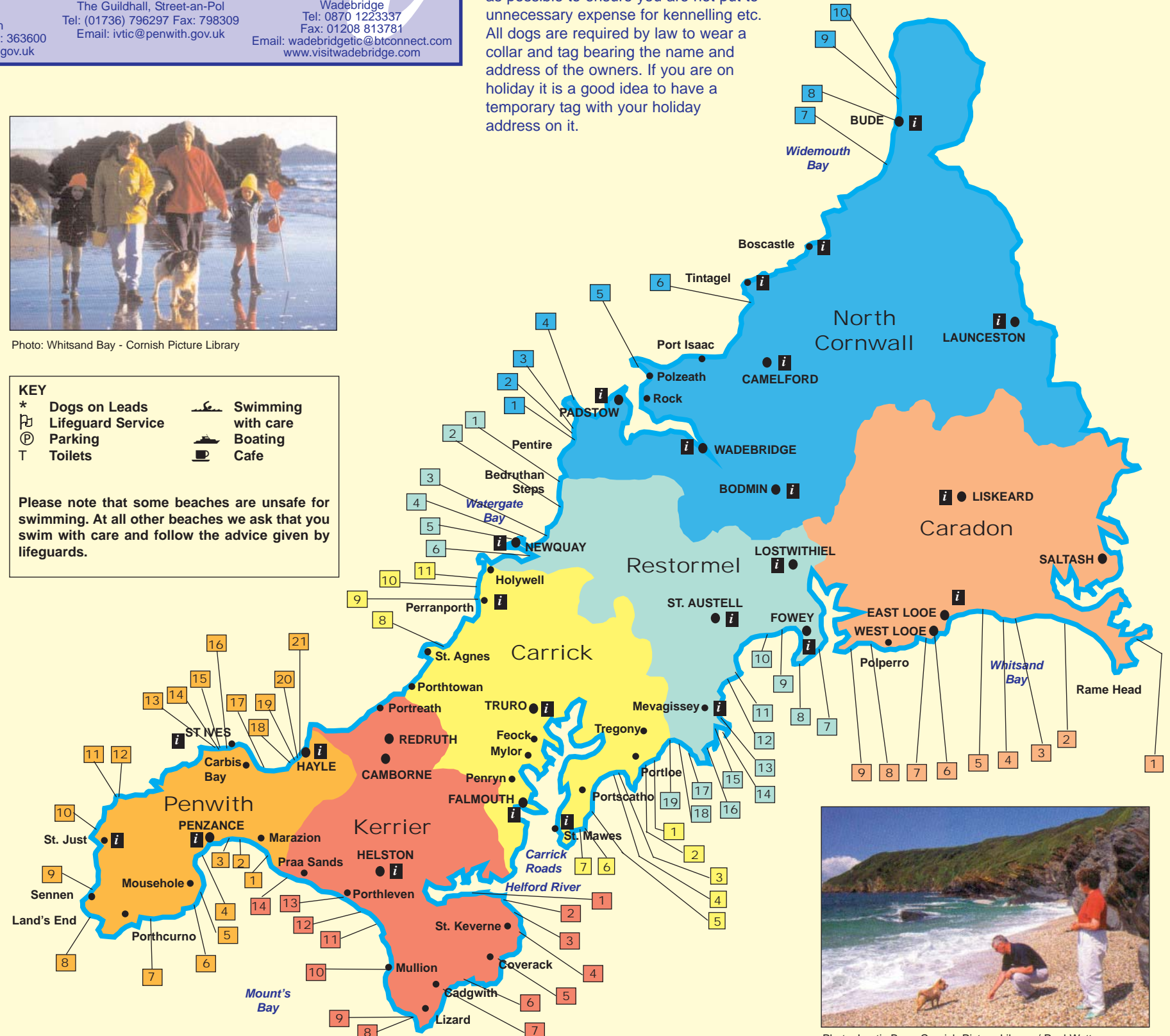
